I started my clay career in Sewanee TN, back in 2006. In attendance at Saint Andrew's Episcopal boarding school I enrolled in my firs clay class not knowing what an impact it was going to have on my life. I studied under Clair Reishman who is the head ceramics instructor at the school. She also runs a well-known art workshop every summer known as Shakerag Workshops. After graduating in 2007 I spent the summer interning with a local potter (Rob Gentry) in my home town of Pendleton SC. Rob has been in business for himself for almost 40 years as a ceramic artist and potter. In late 2007 I enrolled in a professional pottery program in Edgefield SC that was adjoined with Piedmont Technical College. The program was called "Creative economics for professional pottery".
